The recreational facilities of the University are available for campers' use as are the air-conditioned residence halls and food services. A professional staff is with the students at all times in the educational and recreational activities and housing offered during their stay. Evening activities may include swimming, bowling, movies or theater productions, always supervised by our staff. Students who choose to commute to camp are invited to participate in all evening activities.

There are additional charges for some activities. The Student Recreation Center has a small charge for daily use. This may be paid as the student uses the facilities. Other optional expenses are: private lessons (cost varies); Summer Music Festival T-shirt (\$15); group photo (\$8); These charges may be paid at registration.

Applications must be filled out completely and mailed at least two weeks prior to the first day of camp. A non-refundable application deposit of \$50, which reserves your place in camp and is applied to your total camp fees, must accompany each application. Some programs will reach maximum enrollment and students will be taken in the order in which their applications are received. The University cannot be held responsible for lost or stolen items.

FOR YOUR SAFETY AND INFORMATION:

1. The residence halls close each evening at 10 PM with lights out at 11 PM.
2. It is not permissible to leave the campus. If necessary, parents must request off-campus leave ahead of time from the camp director.
