Sheets and pillowcases will be provided. If you want a phone in your room, you will need to bring one to plug in. For long distance calls you will need to dial collect, use a calling card, or use a cell phone. Male and female students are housed on separate floors with counselors available at all times.

Registration (for students living in the dorm for week-long camps) will be from **3-5 PM** on the Sunday that camp begins. Look for a registration table in the lobby of Schneider Hall. A map is enclosed for your convenience. Please bring your payment confirmation with you. Unpaid balances must be paid at registration. If you are receiving a scholarship from your school, this must be received before you register, otherwise you will need to pay the full amount and be reimbursed later. Please be sure your director contacts us before registration.

Meals for dorm residents are provided through a daily debit card usable at the Student Center. (See additional enclosed sheet of info on meals.) Snacks are available at the Student Center and area restaurants are available for you and your parents.

Dismissal from rehearsal or leaving the dormitory for any reason must be approved by the camp director. Parents should make arrangements in advance if they wish to take a student during camp for any other activity. **Written notification is required.**

COMMUTERS

Registration for commuters to week-long camps will be from **6-7 PM**, just prior to the orientation meeting at 7 PM, on Sunday night in Altgeld Hall.

Hours of instruction for week-long camps are from 8 AM to 4:30 or 5:00 PM each day. (See your specific schedule at registration.) All commuters are encouraged to return for the evening programs and activities. The camp director will find inquire daily whether commuters will be participating in each evening's activities. Commuters can be dropped off and picked up at Faner Circle or the flagpole in front of Altgeld.

Meals are not included in the tuition fee for commuters. Students may bring a sack lunch or purchase meals at the Student Center where they can eat alongside the dorm residents.

ALL STUDENTS

Welcome and Orientation for week-long camps will be held in Altgeld Hall on Sunday evening (the first day of camp) from 7-8 PM. Attendance is **required of all participants**. If you have a conflict, please speak with Ms. Presar **Bring your Instrument (see auditions below)!**

Medical Consent Forms are required of all camp participants. Be sure to fill out the enclosed from completely and bring it with you to registration. The camp is under a blanket self insurance policy operated by the university. This coverage is very limited and not intended to substitute for your own medical insurance. Treatment for illness or injury will be at the Carbondale Clinic. Emergencies will be taken to Carbondale Memorial Hospital. Treatment such as surgery requires parental consent before action can be taken by medical staff. This coverage is for emergencies only and is not meant to replace your regular health insurance. Be sure that parents can be reached at all times and that we have sufficient contact information.

Parking is available for commuters and dorm residents with a Temporary Parking Permit. This permit, for specified campus parking lots only, is available at registration for \$10 for the entire week. No high school dorm resident will be permitted to operate a motor vehicle once he/she arrives. Vehicles keys must be checked with the Ms. Presar upon arrival.

BAND (Jr. and Sr. High) STUDENTS: Auditions will be held immediately following the orientation meeting on Sunday evening, so bring your instrument. These are short, chair placement auditions; challenges may be allowed during the first two days of rehearsals.

Our unique camp T-shirts look great for the camp photo! This year our camp shirt will be tie-dyed! The Campers will be participating in a tie-dye session Monday evening of camp. Camp T-shirts are \$15 and will be ready to be dyed. Campers that wish not to purchase a pre-printed camp shirt, can bring their own blank T-shirt to dye.

Camp Photo We will be taking a photo each week of camp. The photos can be purchased at registration for \$8. They will be available on the last day of camp.

Recordings: Due to copyright restrictions, cost, and complexity of securing permission to record, SIUC will not be recording the concerts.

Final Concert Day

Attendance: Campers are expected to attend the final concert. If you are unable to attend, please let the camp director know at registration. Concerts are FREE and open to the public. Please invite parents, family, and friends to watch what you child has worked very hard during the week to accomplish!

Concert Attire: Neat slacks or skirts and dress shirts.

Jazz Improvisation & High School Band – The Final Concert will be held at 1:30 PM on Saturday, June 21, in Shryock Auditorium. Participants are expected to pack and check out of the dorm between 10 AM and noon.

Junior High Band – Rehearsal will end at approximately 3:30 PM on Friday, June 27, in Shryock Auditorium. Participants are expected to pack and check out of the dorm no later than 5 PM. Students will assemble in Shryock at 7:00 PM for final preparation for the concert, which starts at 7:30 PM.
